School Poster Contest

We desire to support the education of school children in understanding water scarcity and the importance of water conservation. Thus, we are encouraging local Monroe County Schools to participate in the World Water Day 2025 contest.

World Water Day 2025 has been designated as March 22, 2025. International World Water Day is held annually as a means of focusing attention on the importance of freshwater. The theme for World Water Day 2025 is 'Save Our Glaciers'. Glaciers are critical to life – their meltwater is essential for wild animals, drinking water, agriculture, industry, clean energy production and healthy ecosystems. Rapidly melting glaciers are causing uncertainty to water flows, with profound impacts on people, animals, and the planet.

Keeping in mind how challenging it can be for elementary school kids to artistically represent a complex idea like "Save Our Glaciers," we've decided to make it simpler and more enjoyable for them this year. The new theme is "Animals Love Clean Water," which is easier for the kids to work with and still promotes an important environmental message.

CONTEST ENTRIES

Poster Contest – Animals Love Clean Water

Students should create a color poster illustrating the theme of "Animals love clean water."

Each poster should be on paper or poster board size 8.5" by 11". Students may use crayon, pencil, watercolor, paint, or markers. Only original artwork will be accepted. Computer-generated drawings will not be considered.

Each entry must have the student's full name, grade, and school name listed on the back of the drawing. Only one entry per student will be accepted.

Posters will NOT be returned. They will remain the property of FEDCO and may be reproduced and displayed with acknowledgment of the artist name included. Only K-8 schools located in Monroe County are eligible to participate.

THE PRIZES

All entries will be judged by a panel of FEDCO employees. There will be one poster winner per grade K-8 totaling nine (9) winners.

Student Prizes

The winning student for each grade will earn a prize pack and have their artwork on display at FEDCO and on its website.

School Prize

FEDCO will sponsor a visit from the Imagination Station for an Extreme Science Experiment at the winning school or a \$500 donation. The winning school is determined to have best overall quality submissions as overall percentage of school population.
